



Book Tips...

- If writing text in the books, use our line guides to keep the writing straight. Place the line guide in back of the sheet that you are writing on, and follow the lines that show through the page.
- All students work at a different pace - some are very excited and work diligently getting their book done long before others. Be prepared with something for the students to do who finish early. Try giving a required time line for students who procrastinate.
- Make sure students have clean hands when working on their books. Using our slip-on jackets will protect and help keep the covers clean until and after completion of the project.
- Excess glue could make the pages stick together if not allowing to dry before closing the book.
- Permanent markers tend to bleed through the pages. Water-based markers work great - make sure the ink is dry before closing the book or working on the next page!
- Pasting pictures and text inside Bare Books works very well, however pasting too much into the book may cause the binding to bulge.
- To protect the finished covers, try our adhesive covers or slip-on jackets. You may also use a spray finish available at your local hardware store.
