This is a good way for your students to learn how to organize information, get to know their classmates, and the book ends up a great keepsake from your classroom. (You may want to make one for yourself!) First get permission from parents to share address telephone, and family information with other students. A good way to do this would be to send home a letter with your intentions along with a fill-in form that includes the information you would like to get. The parents can leave out any information they don't wish to share.

Using one page of a Bare Book for each student, include the following information:

- Student's first and last name
- Parent's name
- Address
- City, State, and Zip Code
- Telephone number
- e-mail address
- Birth date
- Who the student lives with - parents, siblings, extended family members
- What kind of pets the students may have, their name, etc.
- What activities the student enjoys - sports, reading, video games, etc.
- What is the students favorite color?
- What is the students favorite television show?
- What is his/her favorite class in school?
- A photo of the student taken at his/her desk

The above information can be filled in by the student on the page that will be theirs in each book that will be distributed, or on a form that can be duplicated and pasted onto the page. The first page of the book should have the school name, year and a photo of the school. The second page can be information about the school - the principal and secretary name, office phone number, office hours, the school motto, school colors, mascot, etc. The third page, the teacher information with a note from the teacher, and maybe a photo of the classroom (and teacher). The rest of the pages are the students in alphabetical order.
